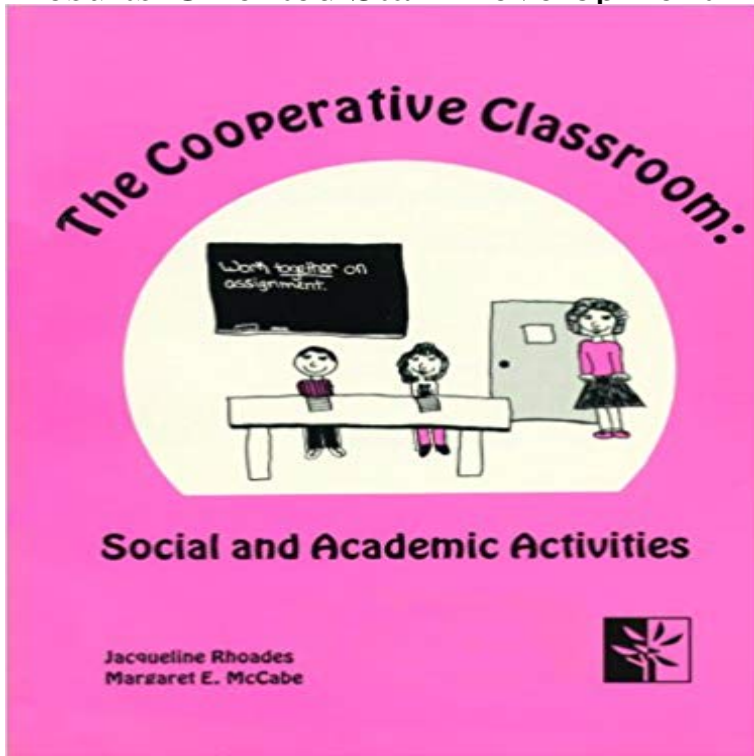


The Cooperative Classroom: Social and Academic Activities/With Results-Oriented Staff Development
