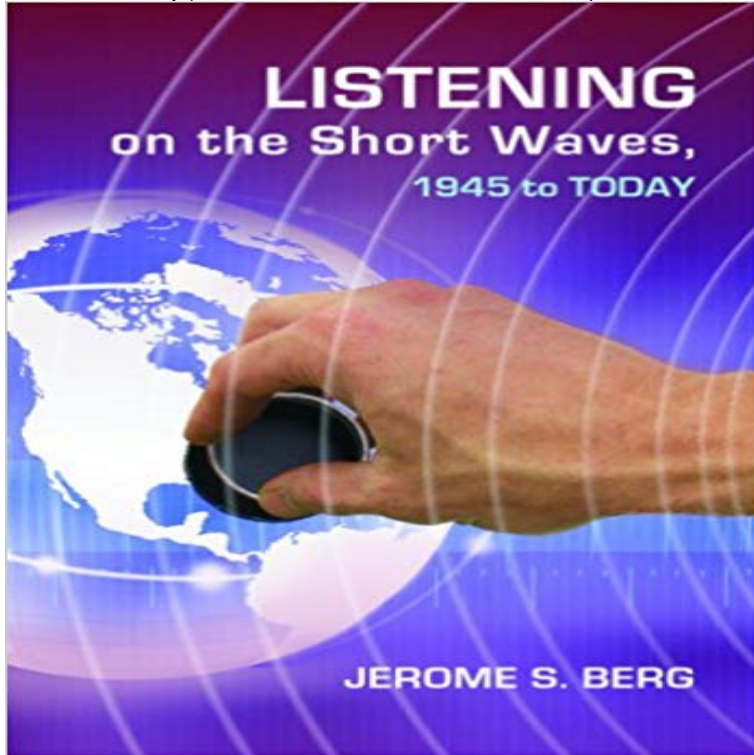


# Listening on the Short Waves, 1945 to Today
