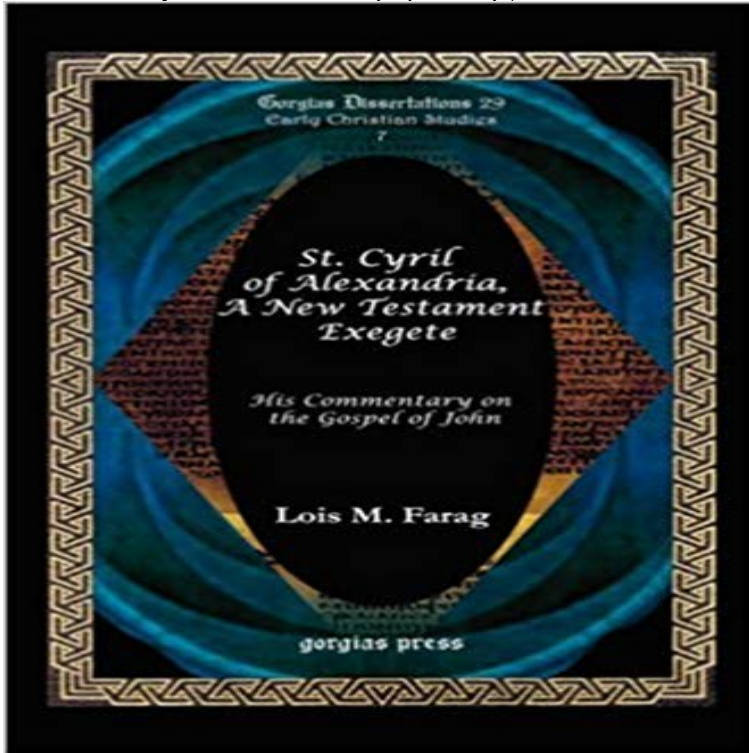


St. Cyril of Alexandria, a New Testament Exegete (His Commentary on the Gospel of John) (Gorgias Dissertations; Early Christian Studies)

It begins with an attempt to place Cyril and his commentary within their context.
