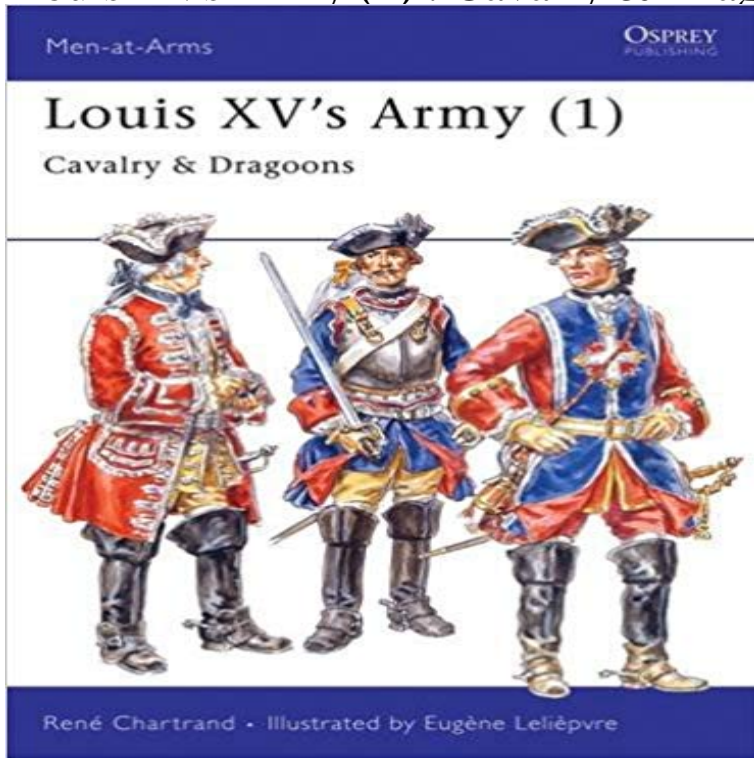


Louis XV's Army (1) : Cavalry & Dragoons (Men-At-Arms Series, 296)
