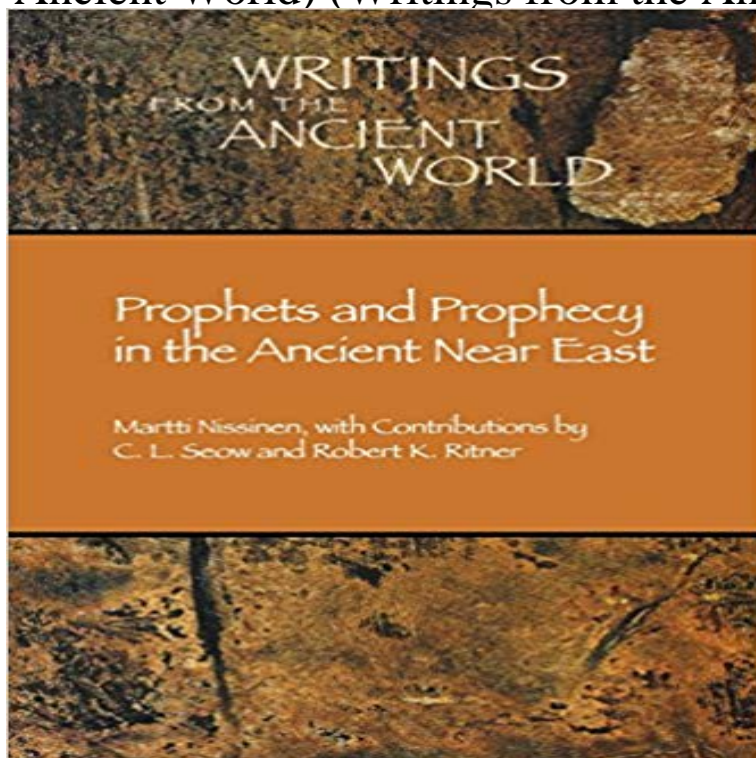


Prophets and Prophecy in the Ancient Near East (Writings from the Ancient World) (Writings from the Ancient World)

It makes these valuable primary source materials accessible to students and general readers in contemporary English along with transcriptions of the original languages, indexes, and an extensive bibliography.
