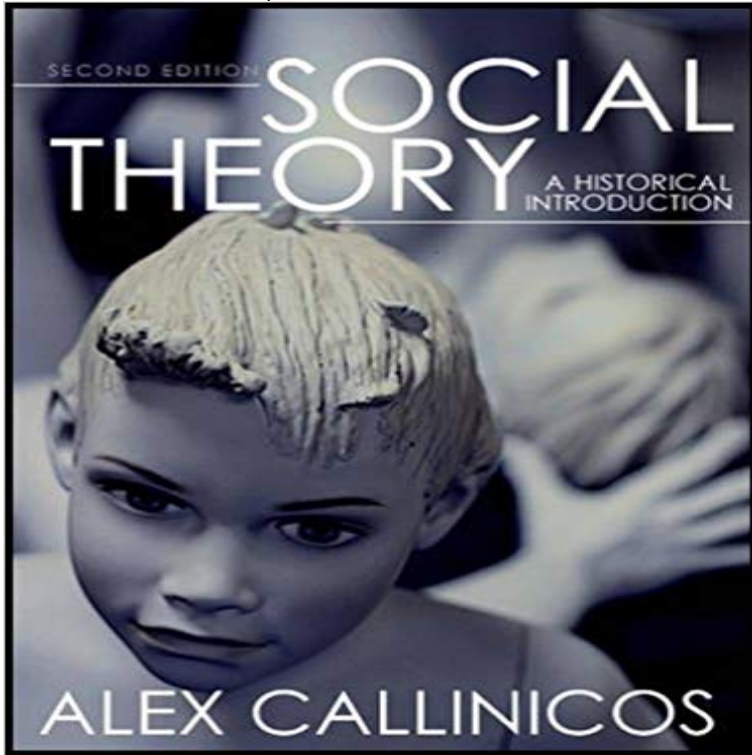


Social Theory: A Historical Introduction
