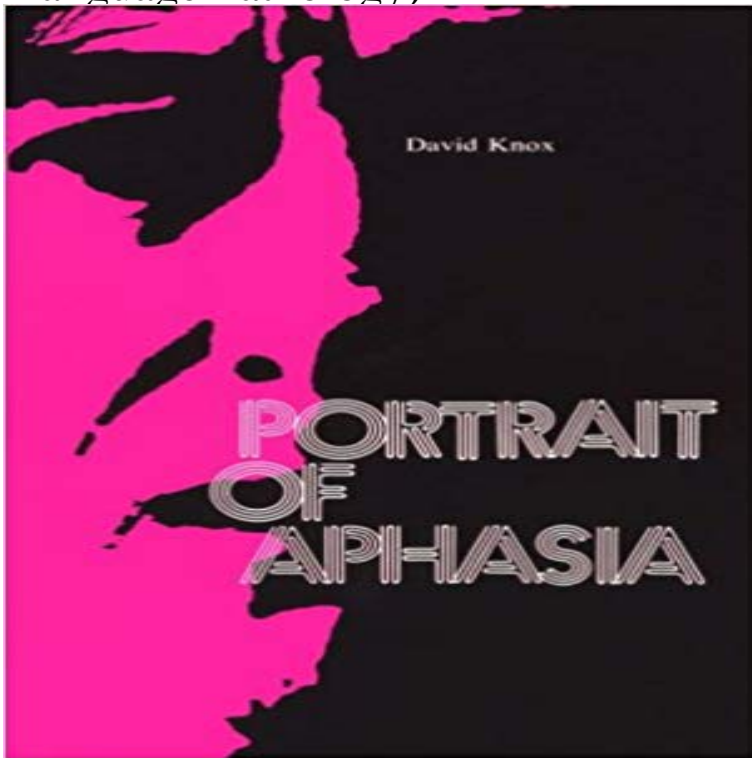


Portrait of Aphasia (William Beaumont Hospital Series in Speech and Language Pathology)
