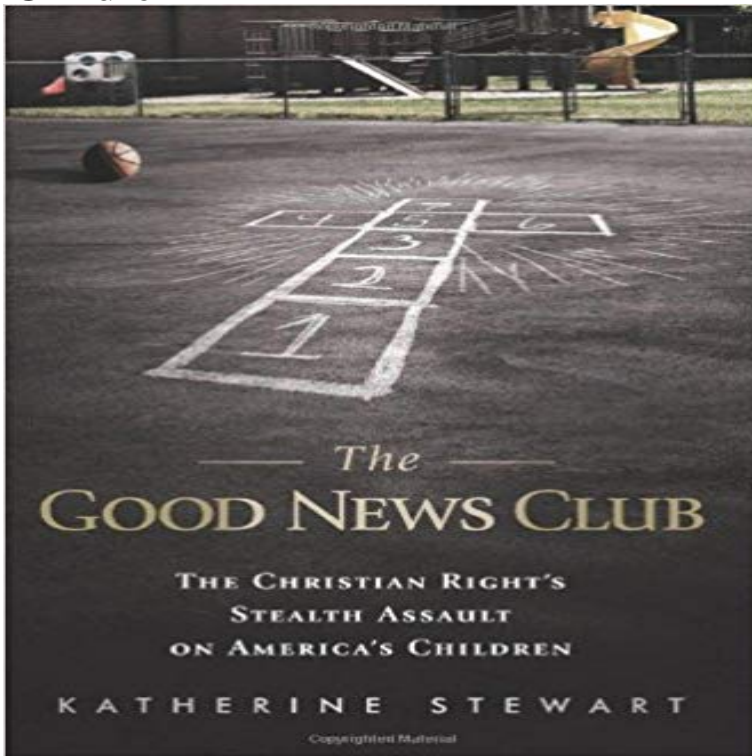


The Good News Club: The Christian Rights Stealth Assault on Americas Children
