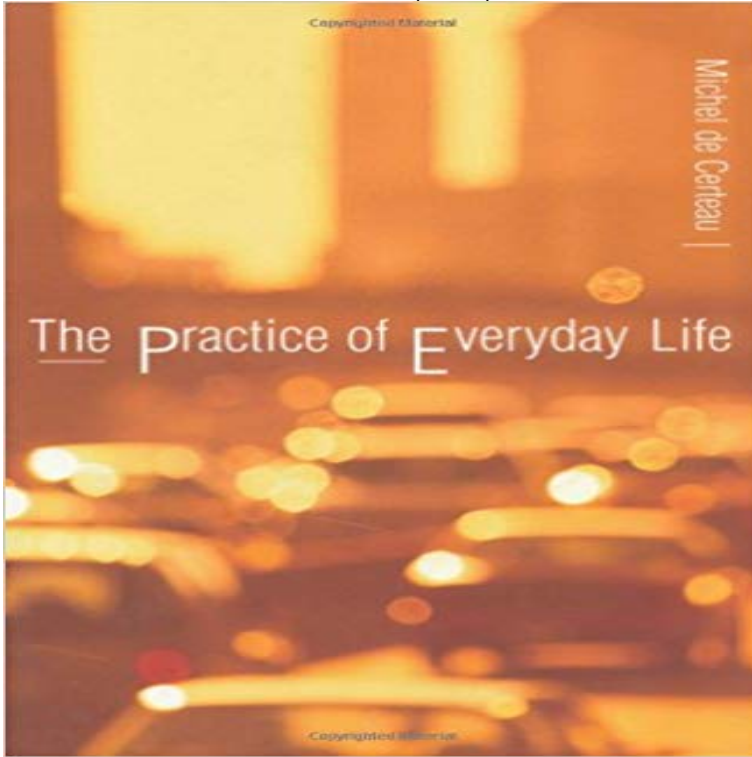


The Practice of Everyday Life
