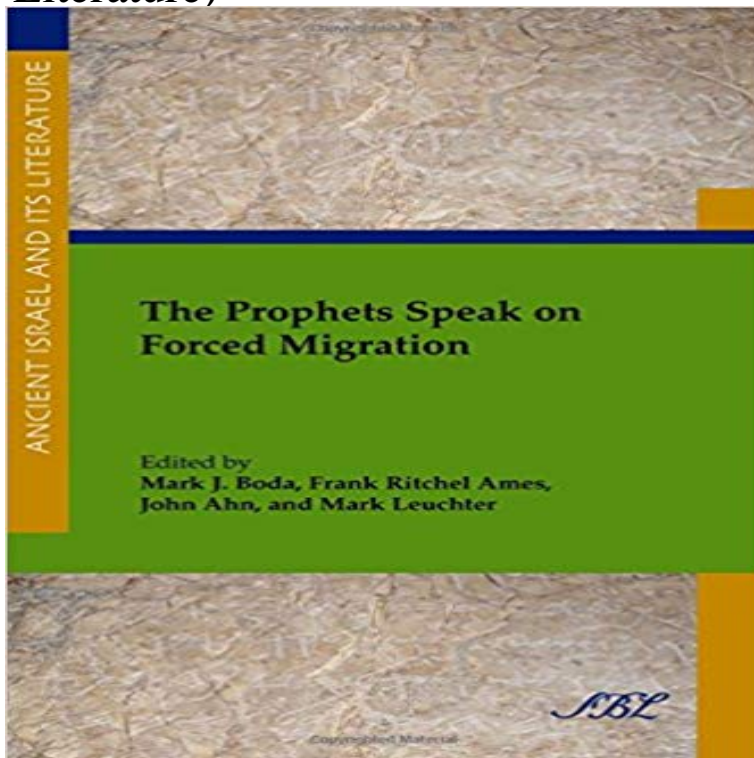


The Prophets Speak on Forced Migration (Ancient Israel and Its Literature)
