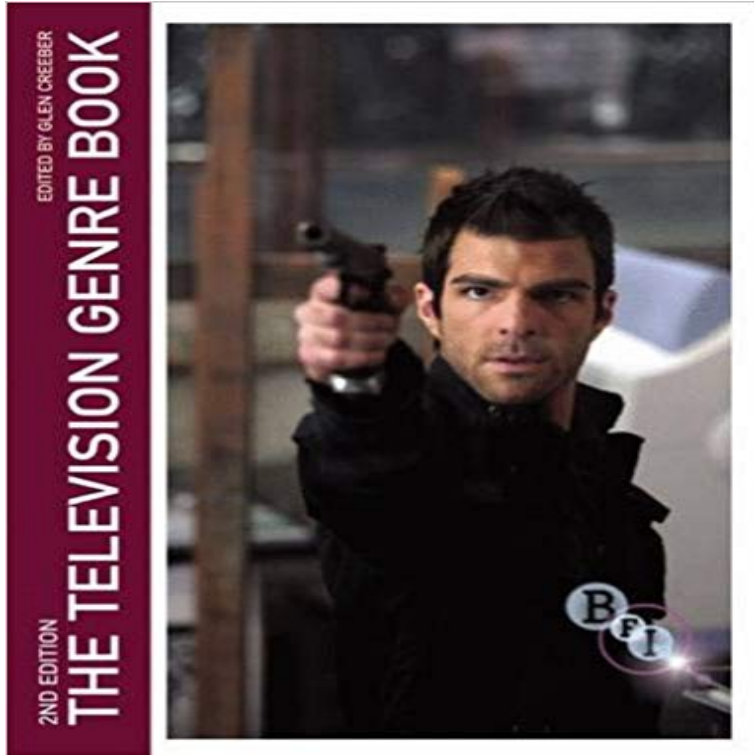


The Television Genre Book
