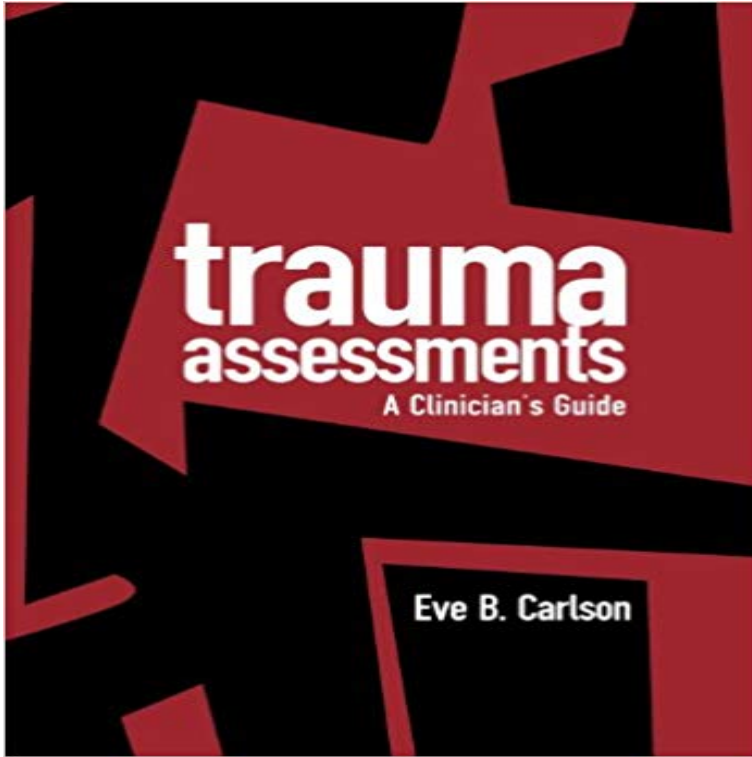


Trauma Assessments: A Clinicians Guide
