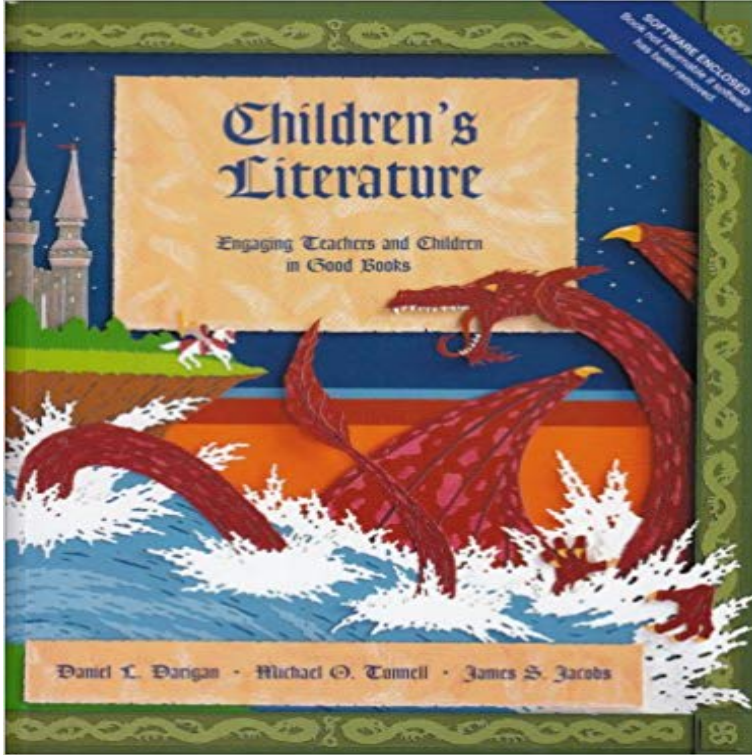


Children's Literature: Engaging Teachers and Children in Good Books
